Pray for Cambodia

Please pray for Cambodia. There has been and alarming increase in COVID cases in Phnom Penh. So far Cambodia has *officially* reported few cases, but this third wave seems to be more serious. The schools in Phnom Penh and Kandal province closed yesterday for at least 2 weeks (having only re-opened on Feb 1st) and the entertainment / hospitality industries have also been told to close. It may be that a national lockdown will be enforced, which will be devastating for those already struggling to feed their families, as there will be little or no work. The country would not cope with a serious rise in hospitalisations and they certainly do not have enough ITU resources to cope.

Please pray for God's protection over Cambodia and supernatural protection over our local partners (Serve Cambodia) who continue to serve the poor as best they can. Also pray for the missionaries who are serving God in Cambodia and for wisdom for the government as they seek the best way to halt the infection. There are few vaccines available yet and those that are don't reach the poor.


