

What's happening this New Year?

Following an announcement from the Cambodian Government on January 11, all education centers will be reopening and school returning this year. Serve Cambodia has worked hard to ensure that their centres were ready for the return of students on February 1. This preparation included a range of maintenance and physical repairs as the buildings have not been used for many months, as well as preparation of teaching plans and materials. The schools will be allowed to operate again provided they adequately obey the guidelines set out by the Ministry of Youth & Sport, such as maintaining physical distance and wearing protective masks. This is a welcome change for students who have been trying to stay on top of their school work at home.




Covid in Cambodia...

As of January 2021, Cambodian authorities have reported a total of 460 cases, 412 of which are said to have fully recovered.

The surprisingly low number of infections is said to be the result of several cultural and environmental factors, including that over 75% of the population lives outside major cities. This means population density is relatively low and as a result, there is less transmission of the virus.
