## Family Fun at Easter

# Easter Sunday - 12th April 2020

Jesus died on Good Friday. Afterwards, his body was laid in a tomb and a large, heavy stone was rolled in front of the opening. His friends were all very sad. They had to wait until Sunday to visit the tomb and when they did, they found the large heavy stone had been rolled away and the tomb was empty. Where was Jesus? You can read more about this in the bible in Johns gospel Chapter 20 verses 1 to 10.

Jesus rose from the dead on that first Easter Sunday morning. His friends were confused, some didn't believe it. But what happened next? Jesus met with his friends, talked to them, ate with them, let them touch him and proved he really was alive again. Jesus was truly special, he was sent by God and he shows us exactly what God is like – loving, caring and ALIVE! Amazing, isn't it?

#### Activity

We probably all like to eat chocolate eggs – the egg is a symbol of new life. It reminds us that Jesus rose from the dead and is alive and that we can have a new life if we believe and trust in Him. Enjoy some chocolate eggs, maybe you can hunt for some in the house or garden.

Memory game – put these things which help to remind us of the different parts of the Easter story in a bag or a box. A leaf, some bread, a cup (for wine), a foot shape, a cross, a round stone, an Easter egg, a nail, a crown (for a King), a picture of a donkey. Bring each one out one at a time and see if you can remember what that part of the story was about. Put them in order of where they come in the events of the very first Easter.

How many words can you make from the letters JESUS IS RISEN? Try it with EASTER SUNDAY and again with GOOD FRIDAY or MAUNDY THURSDAY.

Write a letter to a friend, relative or neighbour (or draw a picture) telling them everything you have found out about the Easter story which we find in the bible.

### Thought

Jesus has defeated the power of death. We no longer have to be afraid, because anybody who trusts in Him has eternal life. Read <u>John 3:16-17</u>
